Surface Mount - Installing the retro fit Stetsbar models is straight forward and requires no modification to your guitar.

Stop-Tail, Hard-Tail, T-Style or OEM

Stop-Tail - These models are designed to fit to guitars that conform to Gibson stop-tail configurations. The unit fits, with the supplied bolts, to the existing stop tail bushings of the guitar.

Hard Tail - Designed for non-trem Stratocaster style guitars and certain Squier Tele models, the base plate of this unit provides the familiar 5 hole pattern to enable you to add Stetsbar functionality without any new holes!

T-Style - We constructed this model to retrofit to Telecaster style guitars. The base plate allows for both the 4-in-line and 3-in-line mounting holes found in the "ashtray" bridge. We also supply a neck shim to adjust the neck angle for a perfect playing action.

OEM - Developed especially for guitar builders, the minimal base plate "hides" below the bridge unit to provide a sleek modern look. The base only requires a shallow pocket to be routed from the guitar preserving tonewood and saving installation time.

Simply put, the Stetsbar is the smoothest, most capable, easiest install, rugged and dependable tremolo you will ever use. 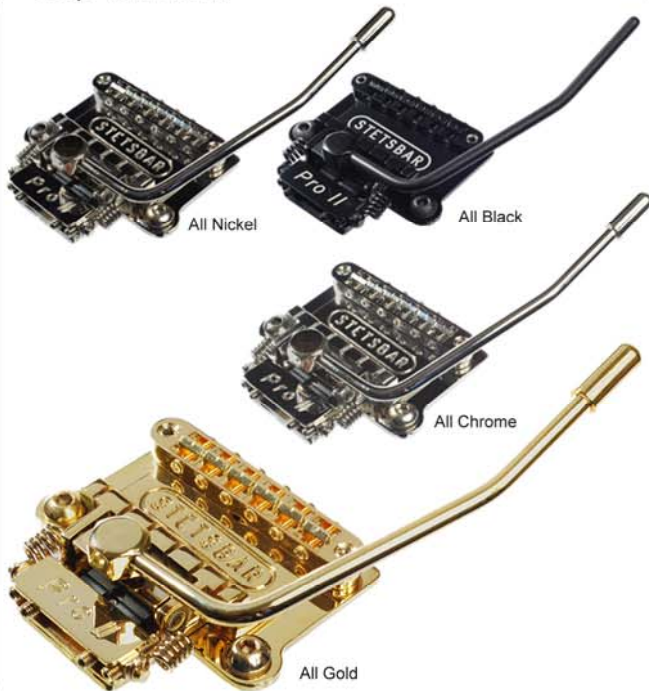
Warranty

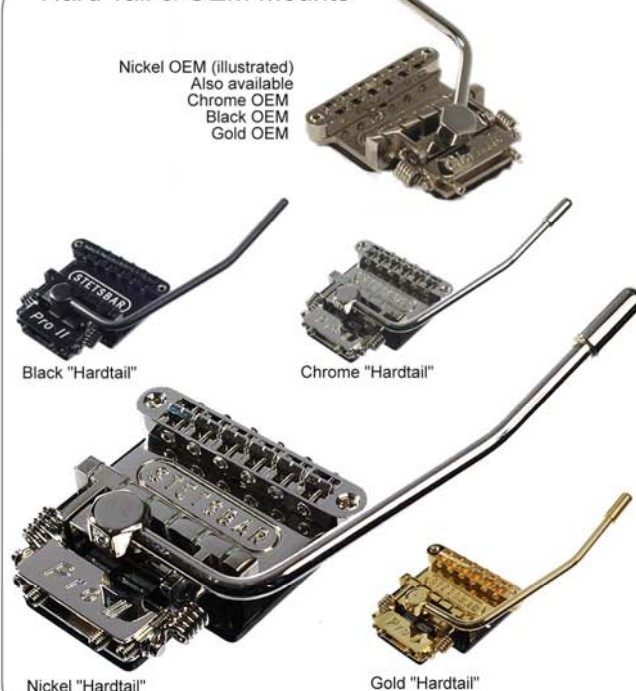
